2023 Association Dues

The 2023 Association Dues were due in January. If you haven't paid your dues yet, please do so. Accounts are in the process of being turned over to the attorney for collections. f you need to find out the balance of which you owe, contact the office and we will be happy to assist you. Association Dues for 2023 are \$309.25. This does not include any late fees, delinquent interest or mailing fees that may have

been accrued.

Trash and Dumping

Please remember that if you have bulk that needs to be picked up, call waste management to let them know. The number is at the end of each newsletter. You can also request pickup online. The link will be available on the front page of the new Campus East website. Leaves and yard waste must be in clear bags. The company will not pick up anything that does not follow their



guidelines. This includes bulk that does not get called in, yard waste in non -clear bags, any trash bags not in the normal trash containers, any trash that is being blocked by parked vehicles.

Everyone must be vigilant in following the trash guidelines from the city. Illegal dumping continues to be an issue in our community. The Board has continually addressed this in meetings and will continue to put in efforts to keep our community clean, but the ultimate responsibility falls on the people dumping illegally.

In Campus East, all trash cans must be stored behind units within their privacy fence unless an exemption has been granted. In Wesleyan Pines, cans must be kept inside a privacy fence, shed, garage, or behind the rear foundation of the home. Please review all trash procedures in the rules and regulations. Association Amenity Updates

Playground: The playground will be open each day at 9am. The time of closure will depend on the availability of volunteers. If we have no volunteers, it will be open until 3:45 pm Monday through Friday **only!** We need volunteers. With-

Please remember that the Easement behind a property is the responsibility of the owner to maintain and upkeep. It can

be so frustrating when someone dumps trash into your easement. Please be courteous of your neighbors. If you have trash, **do not dump** it in the easement! Take it out front and follow the trash guidelines of the city. If you have a cable box blocking your fence and it is DAMAGED or NO LONGER in use, PLEASE CONTACT COX COMMUNICATIONS TO HAVE THE BOX REMOVED OR FLATTEN.

- 1. COMPLETE A CECA 2023 POOL PASS APPLICATION (PLEASE PRINT NEATLY). YOU CAN ALSO REQUEST A DIGITAL VERSION OF THE FORM BY EMAILING THE OFFICE. POOL PASS APPLICATIONS CAN ALSO BE SUBMITTED ON THE CECA WEBSITE. www.campuseastvb.com
- 2. IF RENTING, PLEASE SUBMIT COPY OF SIGNTURE PAGE OF CURRENT LEASE, ALONG WITH POOL PASS APPLICATION.
- 3. ANYONE OVER THE AGE OF 18 MUST SHOW PROOF OF RESIDENCY. (NAME ON LEASE, CURRENT UTILITY BILL, AND FORMAL ID)
- 4. NO MORE THAN 6 PASSES PER RESIDENTIAL UNIT WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 5. SUBMIT A CURRENT PHOTO (HEAD AND SHOULDERS, FACE FORWARD) OF EACH PERSON ON THE APPLICATION, (CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF ONE DO NOT NEED TO SUBMIT A PHOTO) PHOTOS CAN BE TAKEN WITH CELL PHONE AND OR DIGITAL CAMERA AND EMAILED TO OFFICE AT: CECAOFFICEMGR@GMAIL.COM
- *** PLEASE MAKE SURE TO ATTACH THE NAME OF THE PERSON TO EACH PHOTO SENT***
- 6. ONCE THE OFFICE HAS RECEIVED AND VERFIEID ALL NEEDED CORRECT INFORMATION AND MATERIALS, POOL PASSES WILL BE READY FOR PICK UP WITHIN 2 BUSINESS DAYS. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 7. PLEASE CONTACT THE OFFICE BEFORE PICKING UP PASSES TO ENSURE THEY ARE READY.
- 8. PASSES CAN ONLY BE SIGNED FOR AND RELEASED TO THE HEAD OF HOUSEHOLD. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 9. PASSES WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PICK UP AT THE LIFEGUARD STATION ENTRANCE DURING REGULAR POOL HOURS.

Campus East Community Association POOL REGULATIONS

(Revised April 2022)

To Ensure the Safety of Campus East Community Association (CECA/Members and Guests) and to Preserve our Investment in the Pool Facilities, the Following Rules have been Adopted:

- Presentation of a Valid Pool Pass or Guest Pass is required to gain entrance to the Pool Area. No Loitering is permitted even
 if you are not Swimming. You MUST have a Pass! Passes will only be used by the CECA Member listed on the Pool Pass.
 Passes will not be issued to Members with Accounts in arrears, and/or prior year un-corrected ACC violations. If your pool
 pass goes missing or is lost and needs to be replaced, a replacement pass can be purchased from the office for \$10.
- 2. Guests are defined as individuals who do not permanently reside in Campus East or who are not Members of the CECA. Guests are charged a fee of \$10 per visit and must always be accompanied by the Sponsoring Member. Guests may also purchase a weekend pass for \$20 that will be good for Friday through Sunday in a single weekend. Guest passes must be purchased during office hours. Guest passes are non-refundable. Lifeguards WILL NOT issue passes.
- 3. Children thirteen (13) years old or younger must be accompanied by a responsible person at least eighteen (18) years of age. Use of the wading pool is limited to children five (5) years old or younger. Children using the wading pool must be always accompanied.
- 4. Children who wear regular diapers must also wear plastic pants or use swim diapers.
- 5. All persons Must Shower before entering the swimming pool. (Required by the Health Department)
- 6. The use of Alcohol or Possession and/or use of Illegal Substances are Strictly Prohibited.
- 7. Clear or see-thru bags only allowed in pool deck area.
- 8. Swimmers must be in proper swimming attire while using the pool. Altered clothing (i.e. cutoffs, shorts etc.) and the like are not permitted. Street clothes will not be permitted in the pool area except when being worn by supervising adults.
- 9. No Diving allowed in the pool.
- 10. Recreational equipment such as skateboards, skates, bicycles etc., is not permitted in the pool area.
- 11. Children 14 years old and under using the deep end will be required to pass a lifeguard-administered test.
- 12. Running, gum chewing, spitting, horseplay, and use of vulgar language are strictly prohibited.
- 13. Members or guests with visible open sores or bandages are not permitted to use of the swimming pool. (Required by the Health Department)
- 14. Consumption of food and/or beverages in the patio areas only. No glass containers are permitted. All trash must be placed in containers provided. Smokers must use ashtray provided outside the pool gate.
- 15. Use of personal audio equipment is permitted with use of headphones.
- 16. Adults have priority use of the pool furniture. Children will relinquish use of the furniture when asked to do so by the lifeguards.
- 17. Uncooperative persons, those failing to follow any of the above rules or regulations or guidance of the lifeguards, and persons not respecting the rights of others are subject to having their passes revoked. Privileges will not be re-instated without approval of the Board of Directors.
- 18. <u>LIABILITY STATEMENT:</u> Members and guests are responsible for personal property brought to the pool. The swimming pool facility is to be used at the user's/guest's own personal risk.
