Parking

Parking is an important part of living in any community. Each resident deserves to enter and exit their unit safely. Please abide by all parking laws and guidelines. Parking in a Cul de sac must be parallel to the curb. Parking in the middle of a Cul de sac is illegal. If anyone is seen parking in the middle of the Cul de sac, the police will be called, and the driver may be issued a ticket. Parking on any city street is illegal if the vehicle's registration is out of date. You can make an appointment with the DMV or register the vehicle online. Please remember that if you park in front of a mailbox the Post Office will not deliver the mail. Be sure that no owners, residents, or guests park in front of them. It affects everyone.

Please DO NOT PARK in front of bulk trash items. Waste Management will not pick up any bulk waste items blocked by vehicles.

Trash and Dumping:

Please remember that if you have bulk trash that needs to be picked up, call Waste Management to let them know. The number is at the end of each newsletter. Leaves and yard waste must be in clear bags. The company will not pick up anything that does not follow



their guidelines. This includes bulk waste that does not get called in, yard waste in non-clear bags, any trash bags not in the normal trash containers, any trash that is being blocked by parked vehicles.

Everyone must be vigilant in following the trash guidelines from the city. Illegal dumping continues to be an issue in our community. The Board has continually addressed this in meetings and will continue to put in efforts to keep our community clean, but the ultimate responsibility falls on the people dumping illegally.

In Campus East, all trash cans must be stored behind units within their privacy fence unless an exemption has been granted. In Wesleyan Pines, cans must be kept inside a privacy fence, shed, garage, or behind the rear foundation of the home. Please review all trash procedures in the rules and regulations. Association Amenity Updates:

Playground: The Campus East Playground surface has been renovated for the enjoyment and safety of our young residents! If you would like to use the playground, stop by anytime the Campus East Office is open. Unfortunately, due to multiple acts of vandalism, the playground will only be open to children with adult supervision. We would



love to open the playground more often but need volunteers to make that happen!

Tennis Courts: The tennis courts are being resurfaced. They should be ready for use by the end of May 2023. This date is weather dependent.

2023 Annual Inspections

The inspections will take place through March and April. CAN I PAINT MY VINYL SIDING?

Yes, you can paint your Vinyl Siding, but there are a few key things to remember before doing so:

- Use Good Quality Vinyl Paint.
- Flat or Satin Finish
- Power wash to remove Chalky Oxidation
- Do not Paint Darker than Original Color
- As with any Exterior Changes always submit an ACC Modification Form before prior to change.
